I am pleased to report that we made great progress in growing Center House Association (CHA) in 2018. Our membership now stands at 219 members; of those, 22 are 10-Year members and 14 are Lifetime members. We have built, and continue to build, a large and improved contact database in conjunction with our new association management website. Our membership growth campaign has been highly successful this year (a 110% growth rate since 2017!), and we fully expect to keep growing throughout 2019 and beyond.

Because of the generous support of Murtech, Inc., Pratt & Whitney, Patricio Enterprises, the Marine Corps Aviation Association, and our membership, CHA supported the Commanding Officer's enhancement of the environment of Center House through the donation of museum-quality encasements for:

Our 2018 financial report shows a growing but robust organization -- we are proud to say that it was a very good year for expanding our membership rolls and "giving back" to the Barracks. We ended the

year with a positive revenue of more than \$17,000, thanks to our members and generous sponsors! I am pleased to direct our members' attention to our 2018 End-of-Year Report.

In 2019, we continue our "camaraderie" momentum, starting with our Annual CHA Luncheon on Wednesday, 3 April to celebrate the Barracks' 218th Birthday, and continuing with the traditional Fall Post-Parade Season BBQ, followed by two distinguished guest speaker PME discussions planned for November and December.
